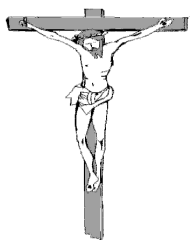

MAUNDY THURSDAY "COME, ADORE HIM"

Come to the Canteen and have a sumptuous breakfast after the 7.15am and 9.15am masses. This weekend: **Mandarin Group**.

The Sacred Triduum is a three-part celebration (one Liturgy, three continuous days) of our Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. Let us participate in all three days.

7.30pm: Mass of the Lord's Supper.
