RESPONSE TO NEPAL EARTHQUAKE

A 7.8 magnitude earthquake hit Nepal on Saturday, April 25. More than 4,800 are feared dead and an estimated 8 million people are affected across Nepal. The damage to property has been extensive.



CHARIS is coordinating the Catholic Church's response to this disaster. It is providing immediate aid of \$100,000, with about half of it in relief supplies such as tarpaulin sheets, water purification units and solar lights to Caritas Nepal.

There will also be a mass in solidarity with the Nepalese community at **12.15pm on Sunday, 10th May at the Church of St. Ignatius**. All are invited.

There will be a fundraising appeal conducted next weekend.
