**NEPAL EARTHQUAKE APPEAL**

The Nepal earthquake continues to take its toll. To date, more than 7,000 people have died. 14,200 injured and 8.1 million lives have been impacted. The devastation to property and home will take years of reconstruction.

Caritas Humanitarian Aid & Relief Initiatives, Singapore (CHARIS) has pledged S\$100,000 in cash and relief supplies. There will be a mass in solidarity with the Nepalese community at **12.15pm on Sunday, 10th May at the Church of St. Ignatius.** All are invited.
